- The Old Covenant is the <u>Law of Moses</u>.
 Corinthians 3:14-15
- 2. What was the problem with the Old Covenant? The people had sinful hearts.
- 3. Under the New Covenant, Christ is our <u>High Priest</u>. **Hebrews 7:26, 8:1, 9:11**
- 4. The blood of Christ takes away our sins, <u>once and for all</u>, in a way that the Old Covenant animal sacrifices never could.

Hebrews 9:11-15, 10:11-17

5. Under the Old Covenant, forgiveness and grace is given in the sacrificial system. Under the New Covenant, forgiveness and grace are provided once for all time by the death of Christ.

Hebrews 7:26-28, 9:11-15, 10:10

6. The Old Covenant is remembered and celebrated at <u>Passover</u>. The New Covenant is remembered and celebrated at <u>Holy Communion</u>.

7. In the Old Covenant, God <u>reveals</u> the problem of sin. In the New Covenant, God <u>solves</u> the problem of sin.

8. In the New Covenant; God places His Spirit in your heart, giving you the <u>power</u> to live a holy life. **Romans 8, 2 Corinthians 3, Galatians 5**
