1. Wives should not resist their husband’s role and position but should voluntarily submit to God’s wonderful plan. **vs. 1**
2. Wives submit to their husbands to glorify God and win their husbands to Christ. **vs. 1-2**
3. Good Christian behavior is a powerful influence and brings glory to God. **vs. 1-2**
4. Christ wants the members of His body to be pure. **vs. 2, Philippians 4:8, 1 Timothy 5:22, Titus 2:5, James 3:17, 1 John 3:3**
5. The most beautiful thing about a woman is her purity. **vs. 2, 1 Timothy 2:9-10, Proverbs 31:30**
6. Purity is true beauty. **vs. 2, 1 Timothy 2:9-10**
7. A Christian woman should focus her life on adorning herself for God. **vs. 3-4**
8. Outer beauty is temporary; inner beauty is imperishable. **vs. 4**
9. Inner beauty is precious in God’s sight. **vs. 4**
10. The Holy Spirit has come into your heart to cleanse and purify you. **1 Peter 1:2**

TODAY’S GREEK WORDS

Hupo-tassō

Tasso = “to arrange, appoint or ordain”

Hupo-tasso = “to arrange under”

Hagnos = pure, uncontaminated by evil

Praios = a gracious friendliness, as opposed to a bad temper

Polutelēs = The very end or limit. It describes something that is the highest price.

Hagiasmos = “purification”
