

“How to Pray”  
**Matthew 6:9-13**

1. When we pray, we address God as our father.  
**Matthew 6:6-9**
2. God is separate and above all that is unclean, imperfect, and ordinary. He is holy.  
**Habakkuk 1:13**
3. When we pray, we should pray that God would be honored and worshiped as holy. **Vs. 9**
4. When we pray, we should long for, hope for, and pray for God’s future, glorious, unshakeable kingdom to be established. **Vs. 10, Hebrews 12:28, Revelation 11:15**
5. Our main concern in prayer should be that God be glorified, that God be worshiped, and that God be obeyed. **Vss. 9-10**
6. God’s will should be the focus of our lives, and God’s will should be the focus of our prayers. **Vs. 10**
7. Are your prayers God-centered?
