

“How Much More”
Romans 5:9-11

1. Justification is God’s act, declaring you righteous in His sight. **vs. 9, Romans 3:24**
2. Justification is God’s response to our faith in Christ. **Romans 3:21-22, 5:1**
3. We are justified by Christ’s finished work on the cross. **vs. 9**
4. How can a person be made right with God? The one who trusts in Christ is officially declared to be right with God, not on the basis of our work, but on the basis of Christ’s work on the cross. **vs. 9, Romans 3:21-26**
5. We can be absolutely assured of our future salvation as children of God based on what God did for us when we were children of wrath. **vs. 9-10**
6. If God sent His Son to die for us while we were His enemies, He will certainly save us in the end, since we are His children. **vs. 9-10**
7. In verse 9, we learn that we are justified. That is our legal standing with God. In verse 10, we learn that we are reconciled. That is our relational standing with God.
