Romans 5:12-21

Today’s Greek words

1. Sin came into the world through Adam. **vs. 12**
2. Death came into the world through sin. **vs. 12**
3. Death came to all men, because all men sinned. **vs. 12**
4. Adam brought death; Jesus brings the gift of God’s amazing grace. **vs. 15**
5. The grace of God is much more powerful than the sin of man. **vs. 15, 17**
6. Adam’s sin brings condemnation; God’s gift through Christ brings justification. **vs. 16**
7. Justification is God’s act declaring you righteous in His sight. **vs. 9, Romans 3:24**
8. Justification is God’s response to our faith in Christ. **Romans 3:21-22, 5:1**
9. We are justified by Christ’s finished work on the cross. **vs. 9**
10. Through one sin, all of humanity was brought under the power of death. **vs. 17**
11. Adam’s one sin brought condemnation to us all. Christ’s one act of obedience brings justification to all who belong to Him. **vs. 18**

basileuō = to be king, to reign, to control

charis = favor, or kindness

hyperperisseuō = to overflow, to abound beyond measure

Perisseuō = to exceed, to be over and above

Hyper = more, beyond, or over
