## "One Man's Actions Affect Us All" Romans 5:12-21

- 1. Sin came into the world through <u>Adam</u>. vs. 12
- 2. <u>Death</u> came into the world through sin. vs. 12
- Death came to <u>all</u> men, because <u>all</u> men sinned. vs. 12
- 4. Adam brought <u>death</u>; Jesus brings the gift of God's amazing <u>grace</u>. **vs. 15**
- 5. The grace of God is <u>much more</u> powerful than the sin of man. vs. 15, 17
- 6. Adam's sin brings <u>condemnation</u>; God's gift through Christ brings <u>justification</u>. **vs. 16**
- 7. Justification is <u>God's</u> act declaring you <u>righteous</u> in His sight. **vs. 9, Romans 3:24**
- 8. Justification is God's <u>response</u> to our faith in Christ. **Romans 3:21-22, 5:1**
- 9. We are justified by Christ's <u>finished work</u> on the cross. **vs. 9**
- 10. Through <u>one</u> sin, <u>all</u> of humanity was brought under the power of death. vs. 17
- 11. Adam's one sin brought <u>condemnation</u> to us all. Christ's one act of obedience brings <u>justification</u> to all who belong to Him. vs. 18

basileu $\bar{o}$  = to be king, to reign, to control

charis = favor, or kindness

hyperperisseu $\bar{o}$  = to overflow, to abound beyond measure

Perisseu $\bar{o}$  = to exceed, to be over and above

Hyper = more, beyond, or over
