- It was Israel's duty to pass on the lessons they had learned to their <u>children</u>. vs. 3-4, Exodus 13, Deuteronomy 6
- 2. It is the <u>parents'</u> joyful calling and responsibility to pass down the faith to their children.
- 3. <u>Pastors</u> and <u>church teachers</u> are not meant to be a substitute for parents.

"Ministers and Sunday School teachers were never meant to be a substitute for mother's tears and father's prayers." Charles Spurgeon

- 4. The future of our church depends more on the quality of our <u>parenting</u> than it does on our kids programs.
 - a. Be a role model.
 - b. Teach them to <u>love</u> the Scriptures.
 - c. Teach them the **Scriptures**.
 - d. Pray for them.
 - e. Share your <u>testimony</u> with your kids. Make sure they know how Jesus radically changed <u>your</u> life.
 - f. Bring them with you when you serve the Lord.
 - g. <u>Connect</u> them with the persecuted church and with the world's missionary force.
