- 1. Accept the one who is weak in faith. vs. 1
- 2. We are free in Christ. vs. 2
- 3. In Christ we have the privilege to live our lives for the glory of God, free from man-made rules.
- 4. Those who exercise their freedom should not <u>look</u> down on those who don't. vs. 3
- 5. Those who refrain from certain things, should not judge those who don't. For God has accepted them. vs. 3
- 6. We have no right to judge each other. <u>God</u> is the judge. **vs. 4**
- 7. Do (or don't do) everything for God's glory. vs. 5-6
- 8. We belong to the <u>Lord</u>, and we have been set free to <u>live</u> for Him alone. **vs. 7-9**
- 9. We have no right to judge each other; we will all stand before the judgment seat of God to give an account of ourselves. vs. 10-12

- 10. We must love one another and determine not to cause a brother or sister to <u>stumble</u> into sin. **vs. 13**
- 11. It is a sin to cause someone else to <u>stumble</u>; we must <u>respect</u> each other's conscience. **vs. 13-14**
- 12. <u>Love</u> governs our exercise of our freedom in Christ. **vs. 15**
- 13. Do all things to build each other up. vs. 19
