1. Accept the one who is weak in faith. **vs. 1**
2. We are free in Christ. **vs. 2**
3. In Christ we have the privilege to live our lives for the glory of God, free from man-made rules.
4. Those who exercise their freedom should not look down on those who don't. **vs. 3**
5. Those who refrain from certain things, should not judge those who don't. For God has accepted them. **vs. 3**
6. We have no right to judge each other. God is the judge. **vs. 4**
7. Do (or don't do) everything for God's glory. **vs. 5-6**
8. We belong to the Lord, and we have been set free to live for Him alone. **vs. 7-9**
9. We have no right to judge each other; we will all stand before the judgment seat of God to give an account of ourselves. **vs. 10-12**

10. We must love one another and determine not to cause a brother or sister to stumble into sin. **vs. 13**
11. It is a sin to cause someone else to stumble; we must respect each other's conscience. **vs. 13-14**
12. Love governs our exercise of our freedom in Christ. **vs. 15**
13. Do all things to build each other up. **vs. 19**
