## "God's Plan for Israel" Part 1 Romans 9:1-33

- 1. God loves <u>Israel</u>, and He chose them to be His Holy people. vs. 1-5
- 2. God is <u>sovereign</u>. His <u>word</u> never fails. His <u>purpose</u> and His <u>plan</u> will succeed. **vs. 6-13**
- 3. God's plan has not failed; He did not intend to save all the <u>physical</u> descendants of Abraham. **vs. 6-13**
- 4. No one's actions can <u>change</u> or affect God's will and plan. He is in <u>complete control</u> of the world. **vs. 14-18**
- God is not unfair, unjust, or unloving; He pours out His <u>mercy</u> and <u>compassion</u> according to His gracious will and choice. vs. 14-18
- God has the <u>right</u> to do whatever He wants. We cannot <u>complain</u> or <u>criticize</u> Him for His choices or actions. vs. 19-21
- God's glorious plan is to make known the riches of His <u>glory</u> by bringing salvation to the <u>Gentiles</u>. vs. 22-29
- 8. The Gentiles received God's grace by <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ, not by <u>works</u>. **vs. 30-33**
