What is the One Hope Project?

The One Hope Project is a ministry of churches in the Coachella Valley working together with ministry organizations to provide Bibles to persecuted Christians.

Since 2008, more than \$440,000 has been raised to cover the costs of sending over 213,000 Bibles to people in persecuted countries!

How much do the Bibles cost?

We are partnering with Frontlines International to have Bibles distributed in an undisclosed country where it is dangerous to be a Christian. You can sponsor a printed Bible for \$7.50 and an audio Bible for \$12.
