"Amazing Grace"

Romans 1-7

- 1. We are justified by God's grace. He owes us nothing. Romans 3:24; 4:4-5
- 2. Justification is <u>God's</u> act <u>declaring</u> you righteous in His sight. **Romans 3:24; 5:9**
- 3. How can a person be made right with God? The one who trusts in Christ is officially declared to be right with God, not on the basis of <u>our</u> work, but on the basis of <u>Christ's</u> work on the cross. **Romans 3:21-28; 5:9**
- 4. God's promises are <u>nullified</u> if we must earn them. We would all fail and lose the promises. **Romans 4:13-16**
- 5. Since we have been justified (declared righteous, cleared of all charges) by faith, we have <u>peace</u> with God. We have been <u>reconciled</u> to Him. **Romans 5:1**
- 6. God has poured His <u>love</u> into your heart through the Holy Spirit. **Romans 5:5**
- 7. We are <u>justified</u> through Christ; that is our <u>legal</u> standing with God.
- 8. We are <u>reconciled</u> through Christ; that is our <u>relational</u> standing with God.
- 9. Adam's one sin brought <u>condemnation</u> to us all. Christ's one act of obedience brings <u>justification</u> to all who belong to Him. **Romans 5:18**

- 10. Grace gives us the <u>power</u> and <u>privilege</u> to stop serving sin and to live serving God. And we are called and commanded to do so. **Romans 6:15-23**
 - "When we yield to Christ, our inward being is radically transformed. A new creation takes place. We receive a new nature, that delights to produce the fruit of the Spirit." (F.F. Bruce)
- 11. We are born <u>corrupted</u> by sin, in <u>bondage</u> to sin, and do not have the power to overcome our sin. **Romans 7:14**
- 12. We are spiritually <u>married</u> to Christ. Romans 7:4
- 13. Christ is the source of spiritual life. If we are united to Him, we will live a spiritually <u>productive</u> life. **John 15**
