- 1. Love <u>God</u> by presenting your <u>body</u> and your <u>mind</u> to Him. vs. 1-2
- 2. Love <u>one another</u>. Do not be <u>arrogant</u> or <u>prideful</u> because we are all part of one body. **vs. 3-8**
- 3. Love without <u>hypocrisy</u>. vs. 9-13
  - a. Love hates evil. vs. 9
  - **b.** Love <u>clings</u> to what is good. **vs. 9**
  - c. Love <u>outdoes</u> others in loving. Love leads by example. vs. 10
  - d. Love is not lazy or sluggish but <u>serves</u> the Lord fervently. vs. 11
  - e. Love <u>rejoices</u> in hope and <u>perseveres</u> in tribulation. vs. 12
  - f. Love is <u>devoted</u> to prayer. vs. 12
  - g. Love gives. vs. 13
- 4. Love supernaturally. vs. 14-21
  - a. Bless those who persecute you. vs. 14

- **b.** Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. **vs. 15**
- c. Do not be <u>prideful</u> or arrogant, but associate with everyone. vs. 16
- d. Never pay back evil for evil; the world is watching. vs. 17
- e. Do everything you can to <u>live at peace</u> with all people. vs 18
- **f.** Do not take <u>revenge</u>, but love your <u>enemies</u>. **vs. 19-21**
