- 1. God has not rejected His chosen people. There will always be a <u>remnant</u>, a group of Jewish people, saved by God's grace. **vs. 1-6**
- God has not rejected His chosen people; salvation has come to the Gentiles to make the Jews jealous.
 vs. 11-15
- 3. The role of the <u>Gentile</u> church in the world today is to make the Jewish people <u>jealous</u> of our relationship with God so that they will turn to God. vs. 11-15
- 4. God has not rejected the Jews. If their rejection brought salvation to the Gentiles, think of how great God's <u>ultimate plan</u> for them must be. **vs. 11-15**
- 5. Gentiles are grafted in by grace, through our <u>faith</u> in Christ. If God did not spare unbelieving <u>Israel</u>, he will certainly not spare unbelieving <u>Gentiles</u>. **vs. 17-24**

- 6. A partial <u>hardening</u> has happened to Israel, so that the <u>Gentiles</u> can come to God through Christ. **vs. 25-32**
- 7. God has not forsaken His beloved chosen people. He is working out His sovereign plan all throughout <u>history</u>, to all <u>people</u>, in order to show His mercy to all nations. **vs. 25-32**
