## **Romans 11**

1. God has not rejected His chosen people. There will always be a remnant, a group of Jewish people, saved by God’s grace. **vs. 1-6**
2. God has not rejected His chosen people; salvation has come to the Gentiles to make the Jews jealous. **vs. 11-15**
3. The role of the Gentile church in the world today is to make the Jewish people jealous of our relationship with God so that they will turn to God. **vs. 11-15**
4. God has not rejected the Jews. If their rejection brought salvation to the Gentiles, think of how great God’s ultimate plan for them must be. **vs. 11-15**
5. Gentiles are grafted in by grace, through our faith in Christ. If God did not spare unbelieving Israel, he will certainly not spare unbelieving Gentiles. **vs. 17-24**

6. A partial hardening has happened to Israel, so that the Gentiles can come to God through Christ. **vs. 25-32**
7. God has not forsaken His beloved chosen people. He is working out His sovereign plan all throughout history, to all people, in order to show His mercy to all nations. **vs. 25-32**
