1. We are blessed with every spiritual blessing in Christ. **1:3**
2. We are chosen in Christ, before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. **1:4**
3. We are adopted as God’s children. **1:5**
4. God’s grace has been lavished on us. **1:6, 1:8, 2:7**

5. We have been redeemed through the blood of Christ. **1:7**
6. We have been forgiven of our sins. **1:7**
7. God’s will has been made known to us. **1:9**
8. We have obtained an inheritance. **1:11**
9. We have been sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise. **1:13**
10. We are alive together with Christ. **2:5**
11. We have been raised up with Christ. **2:6**
