- 1. Prayer takes place in the context of a father/child relationship. The Gospel of John
- 2. Prayer should be done in <u>secret</u>, not to bring attention or praise to yourself. **Matthew 6:5-6**
- 3. Prayer should not be meaningless <u>repetition</u>, but instead should be focused on God's <u>glory</u>, God's <u>Kingdom</u>, God's benevolent <u>provision</u> and God's <u>forgiveness</u>. **Matthew 6:7-15**
- 4. Our Lord spent <u>all night</u> in prayer to God before making a major decision. **Luke 6:12**
- 5. We should follow our Lord's example by <u>regularly</u> going to a quiet place alone to pray. **Luke 5:16**
- 6. We should love and pray for our <u>enemies</u> and those who <u>mistreat</u> us. **Luke 6:27-28**
- 7. We should pray with <u>persistence</u>, knowing that God cares about our needs. **Luke 11:5-13, 18:1-8**
- 8. Everyone who asks receives. We can pray with confidence, knowing that God will give what is good to His children. Matt 7:7-11, Luke 11:5-13, 18:1-8

- 9. Our Lord tells us to pray that God would send out workers into His harvest field. **Matthew 9:38**
- 10.God <u>hears</u> and <u>answers</u> prayer. **Matthew 21:22**, **John 14-16**
- 11.Our Lord teaches us that in our most difficult time, we should <u>pray</u>. **Matthew 26:36**
- 12. We are to keep watching and praying, so that we do not enter into <u>temptation</u>. **Matthew 26:41**
- 13.In prayer, and in life, no matter what the situation, our primary concern and commitment should be for <u>God's</u> will, not ours. **Matthew 26:39, 42**
- 14. We should ask, and keep on asking. Matthew 7:7-11, 26:36-46
- 15. Prayer is not a <u>substitute</u> for obedient service.
