1 Timothy

KEY VERSE: **1 Timothy 4:16**; Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you.

- 1. Elders must teach the church to avoid strange doctrines, and <u>fruitless</u> discussion on controversial questions, and remember that the goal of our instruction is love. 1:3-11.
- 2. Elders must always remember that they have been saved by <u>grace</u> and put into service by <u>grace</u>, even though they were terrible sinners. **1:12-17**.
- 3. Elders must always keep <u>faith</u>, and a good <u>conscience</u>. **1:18-20**.
- 4. Elders must lead the church to be faithful to pray for all those who are in authority, so that we may live a life of godliness, and dignity. **2:1-8**.
- 5. God desires all men to be saved. 2:4.
- 6. Elders must encourage women to dress <u>modestly</u>, adorn themselves with good works, submit to

- <u>authority</u>, and devote themselves to <u>motherhood</u>. **2:9-15**.
- 7. Churches must use Paul's criteria as their <u>primary</u> test for determining the qualifications of leadership.

 3:1-13.
- 8. The church is the pillar and support of the <u>truth</u>. **3:15**.
- 9. Elders must protect the flock from falling away, by teaching sound <u>doctrine</u>, and warning them about deceitful <u>spirits</u>, and doctrines of demons. **4:1-5**.
- 10. Elders must <u>discipline</u> themselves for the purpose of godliness, constantly being <u>nourished</u> by the Word of God, and avoiding <u>worldly</u> myths. **4:6-8**.
- 11. <u>Physical</u> fitness profits some, but <u>spiritual</u> fitness holds promise for the present life, and the life to come. **4:6-8**.
- 12. Elders must be an example of speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity to the flock. **4:9-16**.
- 13. Elders must pay close attention to <u>themselves</u> and their <u>teaching</u>. **4:9-16**.
- 14. When correcting anyone, elders should <u>appeal</u> to the sheep as <u>family</u> members. **5:1-2**.
- 15. Elders must lead the church to <u>honor</u> widows, by taking care of them. But if any widow has <u>children</u> or

- grandchildren, they should take care of their mother or grandmother. **5:1-16**.
- 16. Churches must take care of their elders by; <u>honoring</u> them, (most likely financially) not receiving an <u>unsubstantiated</u> accusation against them, hold them accountable for their <u>conduct</u>, and not appointing them to <u>quickly</u>. **5:17-22**.
- 17. Elders are to lead the church to honor and serve their employers, especially if they are believers. 6:1-2.
- 18. Elder must warn the church about the spiritual dangers of the love of <u>money</u>, and lead the flock to be <u>grateful</u> and <u>content</u> with what they have. **6:3-10**.
- 19. Elders must <u>flee</u> from the love of money, and pursue <u>righteousness</u>, <u>godliness</u>, <u>faith</u>, <u>love</u>, <u>perseverance</u>, and <u>gentleness</u>. **6:11-16**.
- 20. Elders must lead the church to; not be <u>conceited</u>, nor fix there hope on the <u>uncertainty</u> of riches, but on <u>God</u>, who richly supplies us with all things to <u>enjoy</u>.
