D <u>Supremacy</u> of Christ

(ch 1)

- Appointed heir of all things (1:2)
- Through Him, the Father made the world (1:2)
- Radiance of God's glory (1:3)
- Exact representation of God's nature (1:3)
- Upholds all things by the word of His power (1:3)
- Purifies our sins (1:3)
- Sits at the right hand of the Father (1:3)

2 Jesus is the founder of <u>salvation</u> (ch 2)

⁹ But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone. ¹⁰ For it was fitting that he, for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, <u>should</u> make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering." Hebrews 2:9-10 (ESV)

3 Jesus is our <u>High</u> <u>Priest</u>

(ch 3, 4, 5, 6, 7)

- Jesus gives believers rest
 - Believers can rest from work
- Jesus is a better and superior High Priest
 - Superior to Prophets (1:1-3)
 - \circ Superior to Angels (1:4-14)
 - o <u>Superior to Moses</u> (3:1-6)
 - \circ Superior to other priests (8:1 9:28)

"For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart." Hebrews 4:12 (ESV)

Jesus: High Priest of a <u>better</u> <u>covenant</u> (ch 8, 9, 10)

- Jesus is the Mediator (9:15)
- Jesus sacrifice is sufficient (10:10)

And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **Hebrews 10:10 (ESV)**

6 The Father's <u>Discipline</u>

• Don't lose heart

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
